Greg and I have been informed by Jane Conneley, who just turned 84 years of age on November 2^{nd} that she has stage 4 lung cancer. Greg and I wanted to go and visit again but she said "NO". Jane informed us that there will be nothing special just like Les and does not want anyone to spend money on flowers etc., as she believes that people can use their money for food, bills etc. Jane will hold a very special place in everyone's heart and memories and again it is not good bye it is until we meet again.

Saying that, he no longer has the extreme pain that he did and can now get up on his own and get around the house.
