Safety First

Turn signals are important to inform others on the road of our intent to change lanes or make a turn and we should always use them. We should also remember to cancel them after the turn. Even bikes with automatic cancellation should be manually turned off as soon as you have turned. Some bikes leave the turn signals on for what seems like a long time after the turn. This can cause other vehicles to think you are turning and pull out in front of you. Please get into the habit of cancelling your turn signals immediately after the turn, don't wait for them to cancel automatically. Ride Safely.

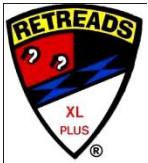
