I was very disappointed that I had no responses from any current or former Retreads except for Carrie Huntington. She is a former Rep for Western PA. Rather than sending out a newsletter with one page, I opted to save it for our next regular newsletter.

“My name is Carrie Huntington. I was a member of and rep of Western Pa Rep for a few years. I really felt unqualified but I did my best.

We took several bus trips to Cleveland, Ohio for yearly motorcycle shows. We enjoyed many group rides and we got together for several picnics.

One of my favorite events were the rallies we had at Conneaut Lake Park. Many Retreads spent the night at the park hotel. We were also allowed to park our bikes in a secure building. Many of us were surprised to be able to see (and smell) a motorcycle using French fry oil for fuel. The gentleman who shared this info with us was also an instructor at Crawford Co. Vo Tech.

A very special speaker at one of our rallies was Dick Klamfoth. Dick raced with several others and was the first to win this race 3 times. 1949, 1951 & 1952. Dick is in the MC Hall of fame.

Dick was instrumental in planning and building “The Daytona 200 Memorial”. It is located behind the band shell. There are photos of many of the racing participants on the inside perimeter of the memorial. Dick planned to have the floor made of bricks. We could have our name on a brick as a contributor of \$25. Our Western Pa Retreads voted to donate and share in this exciting memorial. I have visited the memorial and have seen “our” brick. I would hope many of you who are in the Daytona area would visit this beautiful memorial. Dick passed away 12/19/2019

I gathered as many facts as I could and hope everything is accurate.

I miss my days and my motorcycle friends. There are so many bikers in the “Hill Country” area of Texas. I love living and I am married to Mike Bach. Stop by if you are nearby Hondo, Texas.”

Annual Gray Ghost Inn Weekend Getaway


August 13 - 16, 2021

This year, we've added another day to our long weekend at the Gray Ghost Inn. The Inn is located on Route 100 in West Dover, VT. We will be leaving on Friday morning the 13th and head for home after breakfast on Monday the 16th.

All-inclusive prices are \$389.16 for double occupancy and \$307.80 for single occupancy. On Friday evening at the Inn, we'll dine on a BBQ ribs and chicken dinner. 28 Things To Do With a Bounce Dryer Sheet

1. Tie or pin a dryer sheet to your clothing, or tuck one into your hat to repel mosquitoes when you are working outdoors.
2. They also repel ants, mice and yellow jackets.
3. They will take the odor out of books and photo albums.
4. Remove static electricity from your electronics
5. ...it also helps keep dust from resettling on those surfaces.
6. Dissolve soap scum from shower doors and tubs with a dryer sheet and a little elbow grease.
7. Put one in the vacuum cleaner.
8. Store one in empty luggage to keep them smelling fresh when not in use.
9. Store them in sleeping bags or camping gear.
10. Lay them in drawers or on shelves in closets.
11. Chrome Buffer...just rub a dryer sheet on it.
12. Put them in the top of laundry hampers...
13. Put them in gym bags...
14. Put them in tennis shoes...
15. Put them in garbage cans...
16. Put them in the bottom of litterboxes...
17. Bug cleaner. Wet a dryer sheet. Wipe the grill or windshield of your vehicle until all the bugs are gone
18. Run a threaded needle through a dryer sheet to keep it from tangling.
19. Use them to collect pet hair from furniture.
20. Use them to remove baked on food from cookware. Lay a sheet in the pan and fill with water. Let it sit and then wipe off the food. The anti static agent helps break the bond between the food and the dish.
21. Use them to clean up saw dust after sanding or drilling.
22. Dust venetian blinds with a dryer sheet.
23. Control fly away hair. Rub a dryer sheet over it
24. Rub them on slippers, skirts, etc. to remove the static.
25. Holds soil in flower pots. Just put one in the bottom of the pot before adding your soil.
26. Swiffer duster pad alternative
27. Removes dry sand from the bottom of feet
28. Oh! I almost forgot! You can put them in your dryer too.
